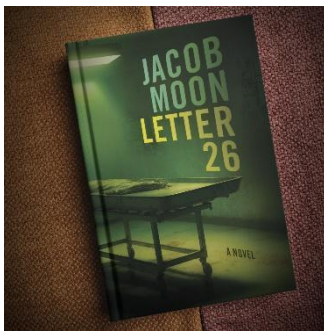




Acclaimed Author Jacob Moon Launches Thrilling New Horror Novel *Letter 26* on December 17, 2024

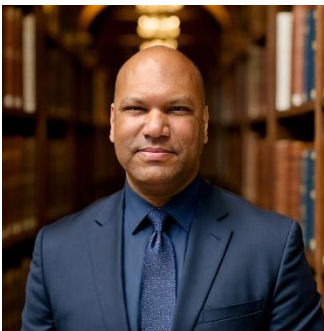
